#### Language point

For / since

#### Aim

To practise the difference between FOR and SINCE.

#### Activity

Students organize expressions of time into categories.

### Organization

Pair work

## Preparation

Make enough copies of the worksheet for the number of students in your class.

#### What do I do?

- 1 Hand out the worksheet.
- 2 In pairs, students organize the expressions of time into two groups, according to whether they are used with FOR or SINCE.
- 3 Feedback as a class, and review the difference between the use of FOR and SINCE.
- 4 Challenge students to make sentences about themselves using the expressions. Tell them that they must make two sentences which are true, and two which are false.
- 5 Divide students into small groups. Student A in each group chooses one sentence and reads it aloud. The rest of the group decide whether it is true or false.
- 6 Continue until students have read out all their sentences.
