#### Aim

To practise indirect questions, asking for information and professions.

#### Activity

Students roleplay situations.

### Organization

Whole class

## Preparation

Copy enough pairs of cards for the number of pairs in your class.

#### What do I do?

- 1 Divide students into two groups. Give each student in one group a "profession" card and each student in the other group a "problem" card.
- 2 Sit students with "job" cards around the room, in their "shops".
- 3 Students with "problem" cards must go from shop to shop, asking (indirect) questions until they find someone who can help them with their problem.
- 4 When students have found the person who can help, they should continue asking questions to get the information on their card.
- 5 Pairs repeat their roleplays for the class.
